

TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES

JULY 28, 2008

A special meeting of the Hampden Town Council was held on Monday, July 28, 2008 for the purpose of introducing a proposed Zoning Ordinance text amendment for public hearing. The meeting was called to order by Deputy Mayor Andrew Colford at 7:00 p.m.

The proposed Zoning Ordinance text amendments are to *Article 3.8.4 Residential B District Conditional Uses* to add institutional buildings in excess of 35 feet in height and to *Article 3.8.6 Special District Regulations* to allow institutional buildings up to 60 feet in height with additional setback requirements.

Motion by Councilor Brann, seconded by Councilor Arnett to introduce this item for public hearing on August 11, 2008 – unanimous vote in favor.
