

Dear MRC Member Community:

The MRC Board of Directors is pleased to provide the enclosed check for the quarterly cash distribution return to Amending Charter Municipalities and new Charter Municipalities for the Third Quarter of 2008. The payment is based on tipping fees, plant performance and asset activity in the Second Quarter of 2008.

Consistent with MRC Board-approved policies and Transaction Guidelines, a total distribution amount of \$1,094,962.29 to the Amending Charter Municipalities was approved to meet the system-wide target value of \$45.00 per ton, which is tipping fees less cash distributions. The tipping fee for the Second Quarter was \$68.50. Therefore, on average as a group, the Amending Charter Municipalities need a cash distribution of \$1,094,962.29 in order to achieve the \$45.00 per ton target. This total amount is the product of \$23.50 per ton and 46,594.14 tons of solid waste delivered by all Amending Charter Municipalities in the Second Quarter of 2008. New Charter Municipalities also received funds from Performance Credits for Second Quarter equal to tons delivered multiplied by the difference between the tipping fee of \$68.50 and the new Charter Municipality target value of \$54.00 per ton.

This cash distribution to Amending Charter Municipalities was generated from Performance Credits in the amount of \$834,652.06 and \$260,310.23 in Net Cash Flow received as a result of PERC ownership interests. Funds from Performance Credits in the amount of \$74,455.00 were distributed to new Charter Municipalities.

The MRC Board of Directors thanks all MRC members for their efforts and contributions in support of the MRC mission of an environmentally safe, long-term solid waste disposal solution at a reasonable and affordable cost.

§ 653. Hearings; bureau review; appeal

1. **Hearing.** The municipal officers or, in the case of unincorporated places, the county commissioners of the county in which the unincorporated place is located, shall hold a public hearing for the consideration of applications for new on-premise licenses and applications for transfer of location of existing on-premise licenses. The municipal officers or county commissioners may hold a public hearing for the consideration of requests for renewal of licenses, except that when an applicant has held a license for the prior 5 years and a complaint has not been filed against the applicant within that time, the applicant may request a waiver of the hearing.
    - A. The bureau shall prepare and supply application forms. [1993, c.730, §27(amd).]
    - B. The municipal officers or the county commissioners, as the case may be, shall provide public notice of any hearing held under this section by causing a notice, at the applicant's prepaid expense, stating the name and place of hearing, to appear on at least 3 consecutive days before the date of hearing in a daily newspaper having general circulation in the municipality where the premises are located or one week before the date of the hearing in a weekly newspaper having general circulation in the municipality where the premises are located. [1995, c.140, §4 (amd).]
    - C. If the municipal officers or the county commissioners, as the case may be, fail to take final action on an application for a new on-premise license, for transfer of the location of an existing on-premise license or for renewal of an on-premise license within 60 days of the filing of an application, the application is deemed approved and ready for action by the bureau. For purposes of this paragraph, the date of filing of the application is the date the application is received by the municipal officers or county commissioners. This paragraph applies to all applications pending before municipal officers or county commissioners as of the effective date of this paragraph as well as all applications filed on or after the effective date of this paragraph. This paragraph applies to an existing on-premise license that has been extended pending renewal. The municipal officers or the county commissioners shall take final action on an on-premise license that has been extended pending renewal with 120 days of the filing of the application. [1999, c589, §1 (amd).]
  2. **Findings.** In granting or denying an application, the municipal officers or the county commissioners shall indicate the reasons for their decision and provide a copy to the applicant. A license may be denied on one or more of the following grounds:
    - A. Conviction of the applicant of any Class A, Class B or Class c crime: [1987, c45, Pt.A§4 (new).]
    - B. Noncompliance of the licensed premises or its use with any local zoning ordinance or other land use ordinance not directly related to liquor control; [1987, c.45, Pt.A§4(new).]
    - C. Conditions of record such as waste disposal violations, health or safety violation or repeated parking or traffic violations on or in the vicinity of the licensed premises and caused by persons patronizing or employed by the licensed premises or other such conditions caused by persons patronizing or employed by the licensed premises that unreasonably disturb, interfere with or affect the ability of persons or businesses residing or located in the vicinity of the licensed premises to use their property in a reasonable manner; [1993, c.730, §27 (amd).]
    - D. Repeated incidents of record of breaches of the peace, disorderly conduct, vandalism or other violations of law on or in the vicinity of the licensed premises and caused by persons patronizing or employed by the licensed premises; [1989, c.592,§3 (amd).]
    - E. A violation of any provision of this Title; and [1989, c.592, §3 (amd).]
    - F. A determination by the municipal officers or county commissioners that the purpose of the application is to circumvent the provisions of section 601. [1989, c.592, §4 (new).]

3. **Appeal to bureau.** Any applicant aggrieved by the decision of the municipal officers or county commissioners under this section may appeal to the bureau within 15 days of the receipt of the written decision of the municipal officers or county commissioners. The bureau shall hold a public hearing in the city, town or unincorporated place where the premises are situated. In acting on such an appeal, the bureau may consider all licensure requirements and findings referred to in subsection 2.



**Subject:** Proposed Sewer Hook-on @ 421 Old County Road

---

As we have discussed previously, the owner of 421 Old County Road would like to connect their existing dwelling to the public sewer. Several weeks ago (as the result of a complaint) we identified an illicit discharge of partially treated wastewater onto the sidewalk on Route 1A. Following that complaint, I notified the owners of the mobile home located on the lot that their subsurface wastewater disposal system was malfunctioning. They have hired a site evaluator/engineer to investigate possible sewage disposal options. In speaking with the owner recently, I have learned that they would prefer to connect to the public sewer rather than install a replacement septic system. In order to make the required connection, the discharge line (or force main) would need to run parallel with the travelled way of the road for a distance of approximately 200 feet within the Town's right-of-way. I am told by our Town Attorney that this sort of piping arrangement would require a formal contract and/or easement between the Town and the owner of the property/piping.

I am writing this memo in hopes that this issue could be referred to the Council's Public Works Committee. I hope to have a preliminary diagram of how the system would be set up prior to the meeting.

Recently the Town of Hampden Fire Department was awarded an Americorps grant subject to Council approval. The grant was secured through the efforts of Lt. Ray Pipes.

The Americorps Emergency Response Corps was created to address the shortage of volunteers in fire departments. The Americorps Member responsibilities will include:

1. Recruit and retain emergency response volunteers
2. Increase available manpower for emergency response
3. Enhance public safety initiatives
4. Provide additional community service activities

The Emergency Response Corps provides members with a comprehensive benefits package for 1700 hours commitment over an 11 month period. Benefits include:

- \$11,400 in pay
- \$4725 in an Americorps education scholarship
- Health benefits
- Training opportunities
- Student loan forbearance
- Childcare reimbursement if income eligible

The Town of Hampden would be required to pay Americorps \$8500 within the first four months of the program. The Emergency Response Corps member would be an employee of Americorps while performing duties during the 1700 hours required. Worker's Compensation claims, if any would be the responsibility of Americorps. Any hours worked outside the Americorps hours are paid as normal for call firefighter personnel.

The Emergency Response Corps member would augment our existing staff and the schedule would mirror as closely as possible our peak call hours.
