- During the month of October the Code Enforcement Office received a total of 27 permit/license applications. This included:
 - 1 – New Mobile Homes
 - 3 – Building Addition
 - 1 – Certificate of Compliance
 - 7 – Internal Plumbing
 - 1 – Septic System
 - 1 – Building Alteration
 - 10 – Accessory Structure
 - 3 – Vicutaler’s
- A total of \$2,051.00 in fees were collected in the month of October. This compares to \$1,566.20 the previous year.
- The Code Enforcement Team conducted 39 inspections during the month of October.
- The Code Enforcement Team underwent a personnel change starting this Month
 - Jared LeBarnes was appointed at the Building Official/Inspector and will also assume duties of the Alternate Plumbing Inspector when he finishes certifications.
 - Myles Block continues as the Code Enforcement Officer & Alternate Building Inspector and was appointed as the Alternate Fire Inspector.
 - Jason Lundstrom was appointed as the Fire Inspector, Health Officer, and Alternate Building Official/Inspector and will continue as the Alternate Code Enforcement Officer.
 - This new distribution will give the Town coverage for all inspection types close to 5 days a week every week; when everyone becomes fully certified.
 - The Code Enforcement Team has a new work schedule in place and that calendar can be found on the Town website under Code Enforcement.
- Vicutaler’s inspection performed and license approved for Subway, Angelo’s Pizzeria and Coffee Break Cafe.
