**Treasurer's Financial Statement

1. Total Town Indebtedness

* Excludes the Town's share of the \$13,971,672.58 debt of RSU 22 outstanding, approximately 90% of which will be paid by the State.

2. Costs

At an estimated maximum interest rate of 4.60%, for a term of 30 years, the estimated costs of this bond issue will be:

Principal	\$1,000,000
Interest	<u>\$845,600</u>
Total Debt Service	\$1,845,600

3. Validity

The validity of the bonds is not affected by any errors in the above estimates. If the actual amount of the total debt service for the bond issue varies from the estimate, the approval by the councilors is nevertheless conclusive and the validity of the bond issue is not affected by reason of the variance.
